## Cyclamen

These flower in late autumn, winter and early spring. Many varieties are available, with the color of the swept-back flowers ranging from white, through red, to purple. Some varieties have frilled or perfumed flowers. Although usually treated as an annual, if the tubers are dried off in the late spring and rested during the summer months, these plants can last for many years, although they do not mix well with other plants. They are ideal for colorful displays in entrance halls or period rooms where conditions are not excessively hot.

### Care Requirements:

**Light:** Medium/High. A sunny east or west window

**Water:** Keep the soil moist Sept - May, nearly dry June-August. Never pour water directly on the tuber, instead stand the pot in water for 15 minutes.

**Temperature:** Cool 60-70 degrees.

**Fertilizer:** Use blooming plant food Sept.-May only, every two weeks.
