

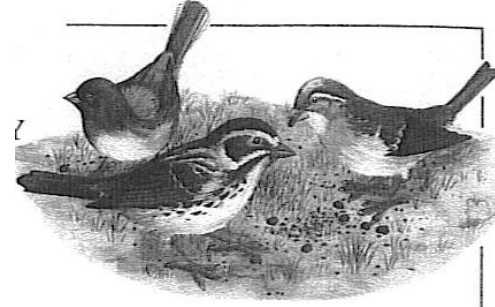

### Sunflower Seeds

Cardinal, goldfinch, purple finch, Harris's sparrow, white-crowned sparrow, dark-eyed junco, crossbill, cowbird, towhee, blackbird, grackle, mountain chickadee, black-capped chickadee, titmouse, yellow-rumped warbler, white-breasted nuthatch, red breasted nuthatch, brown-headed nuthatch, grosbeak, jay.

### Peanut Butter

Cardinal, song sparrow, chipping sparrow, tree sparrow, field sparrow, dickcissel, mockingbird, black-capped chickadee, brown-capped chickadee, titmouse, yellow-rumped warbler, pine warbler, wood thrush, summer tanager, Carolina wren, red-bellied woodpecker, bluebird.

### Nut Meats, Peanuts

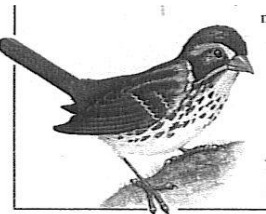
Goldfinch, purple finch, house finch, white-throated sparrow, dark-eyed junco, bunting, towhee, red-winged blackbird, grackle, northern oriole, catbird, thrasher, black-capped chickadee, Carolina chickadee, mountain chickadee, titmouse, myrtle warbler, orange-crowned warbler, pine warbler, white-breasted nuthatch, hermit thrush, Carolina wren, red-bellied woodpecker, red-breasted nuthatch, brown-headed nuthatch, starling, kinglet, bluebird, yellow-bellied sapsucker, red headed woodpecker, mourning dove, blue jay, Steller's jay, mockingbird.

### Millet

Purple finch, house finch, song sparrow, slate-colored junco, dickcissel, cowbird, red-winged blackbird, field sparrow, goldfinch, fox sparrow, mourning dove.

### Fruit

House finch, towhee, red-winged blackbird, summer tanager, yellow-bellied sapsucker, northern oriole, robin, western tanager, catbird, mockingbird, starling, red-bellied woodpecker, red-headed woodpecker, dove, bluebird, fox sparrow, Steller's jay, hermit thrush.



### Thistle

Finch, sparrow, chickadee, titmouse, towhee, junco, mourning dove.

### Suet

Field sparrow, dark-eyed junco, house finch, song sparrow, chipping sparrow, tree sparrow, grackle, mockingbird, catbird, California thrasher, black-capped chickadee, mountain chickadee, brown capped chickadee, orange-crowned warbler, yellow-rumped warbler, pine warbler, white-breasted nuthatch, red-breasted nuthatch, starling, kinglet, wood thrush, hermit thrush, summer tanager, Carolina wren, red-bellied woodpecker, red-headed woodpecker, yellow-bellied sapsucker, northern oriole, blue jay, titmouse,

### Wheat

Dark-eyed junco, dickcissel, Harris's sparrow, grackle.

### Oats

Dickcissel, black-capped chickadee, chipping sparrow.

### Pumpkin Seeds

Tree sparrow, purple finch, black-capped chickadee

### Squash Seeds

Purple finch, black-capped chickadee, bluebird.

### Raisins

Wood thrush, bluebird, catbird, thrasher, mockingbird, red-winged blackbird, robin.

### Cheese

Catbird, thrasher, Carolina wren.

### Scratch Food

Purple finch, cardinal, cowbird

### Weed Seeds

White-throated sparrow, fox sparrow, dove, field sparrow.

## Who Eats What? Cont...

### Mixed Seeds

Buntings, towhee, starling, kinglet, California thrasher, black-capped chickadee, red-bellied woodpecker.

### Grains

Rusty blackbird, mockingbird, California thrasher, red-headed woodpecker, dove.

### Cherry & Autumn Elaeagnus

Cardinal, bluebird, flicker, catbird

### Mountain Ash

Bluebird, flicker, waxwing, western tanager, hermit thrush

### Black Gum

Bluebird, robin, flicker, hermit thrush.

### Dogwood & Sumac

Hermit thrush, wood thrush, robin

### Virginia Creeper

Hermit thrush, flicker, robin, bluebird.

### Cornmeal

Yellow-rumped warbler, pine warbler, wood thrush

### Sumac & Goldenrod Seeds

Yellow-rumped warbler, wood warbler, robin

### Spruce, Pine, Fir, Maple Seeds

White-breasted nuthatch, red-breasted nuthatch, red crossbill.

### Berries

Indigo bunting, white-throated sparrow, towhee, chipping sparrow, starling, kinglet, bluebird, flicker, Carolina wren, northern oriole, California thrasher, mountain chickadee, cardinal, waxwing, wood thrush, mockingbird, black-capped chickadee, yellow-rumped warbler, red-headed woodpecker, robin, blue jay.
