Rose Duties Holiday Calendar

| March 30 | -Resist urge to uncover Roses!! |
| April 15 (Tax Day) | -Remove winter cover
-Replace roses that didn't make it
-Final prune to green wood
-Spray for fungus and insects; continue every 7 to 10 days Until Columbus Day
-Water deeply at least once a week until Columbus Day
-Fertilize; repeat per instructions on product label |
| May 30 (Memorial Day) | -Fertilize
-Continue spraying for fungus every 7 to 10 days
-Spray for insects only when they appear
-Continue watering at least once a week |
| July 4 (Independence Day) | -Fertilize
-Continue spraying for fungus every 7 to 10 days
-Spray for insects only when they appear
-Continue watering at least once a week |
| 1st Monday in September (Labor Day) | -Fertilize for the last time this season
-Continue spraying for fungus every 7 to 10 days
-Spray for insects only when they appear
-Continue watering at least once a week |
| October 14 (Columbus Day) | -Discontinue spraying for the season
-Stop deadheading roses to prepare them for dormancy
-Discontinue watering for the season |
| November 28 (Thanksgiving) | -Cover base of roses with mulch leaves or manure 12-18 inches high for winter
-Prune to 30 inches high to prevent whipping in winter wind (except climbers & large shrubs) |
| December 25 (Christmas) | -Give roses as a gift to friends and relatives
-Read a good rose book |
